2.\$330 - Commercial Booth Sales: Commercial Vendors can make sales of cultural or products that have a cultural theme/aspect upon application approval. A booth (1 - 2'x6' Table + 2 Chairs) will be provided for sales of merchandise or distribution of promotional materials.

All commercial vendors must have a Special Event License.

Enforcement Section will determine if a license is required depending upon the vendor already has a license or not and what type of they have. All required supporting documents for license application have to reach the MCBA office 3 weeks before the event date.

Each commercial vendor must produce a certificate of insurance evidencing proof General Liability Insurance in the amount of \$2,000,000 and City Mississauga must be added to the Insurance as an additional insured.

Booths do not require a license if they are displaying/promoting/giving items and no transaction is involved at the event.

3.\$330 – Food Truck Food Booth: Food Vendor needs to pay the application fee for Special Event License and provide the following document for application: Certificate of insurance evidencing proof of General Liability Insurance in the amount \$2,000,000 and the City of Mississauga must be added to Insurance as an additional insured, and the City of Mississauga must be added to Insurance as an additional insured, TSSA Propane Inspection and Region of Peel Health Inspection.

MCBA reserves the right to select appropriate food vendor for event.
